Many of our Executive MBA graduates go on to pursue our Henley DBA – one of only eleven programmes globally to have gained the prestigious AMBA accreditation. Practice-based, challenging and highly-rewarding, it's a fantastic opportunity to accelerate your career and maximise your competitive edge. You'll develop advanced research capabilities and analytical thinking skills, and learn how to apply them to real and complex business cases – enabling you to make a lasting impact not only on your organisation, but on the wider arena of contemporary business theory.



Henley's DBA is a part-time degree programme comprising of two linked stages of study over a period of around four to six years. In the first stage, you'll develop the essential knowledge and skills for research through a series of specialist workshops and assessments. The second stage focuses on your primary research and its application to real-world situations.
